

CANADIAN CLUB DISTILLERY

Hiram Walker, a successful grain merchant, founded what would become Canadian Club in 1858. The first distillery was established in Walkerville, Ontario because of the exceptional quality of the local grains there. In those early days, if you wanted whisky, you took your own jug or bottle to the local store and filled it from a generic barrel. Hiram didn't care for that idea.

Hiram's whisky was different – smooth and easy to drink and he wanted people to know who made it. So he branded the barrels with his name on it as a signature of confidence and assurance quality.

Canadians soon took a liking to the whisky, and came to love it as their own. In America it was considered special as it was sold exclusively sold in finer gentlemen's clubs of the era. Soon the whisky became known as "Club Whisky". It was so popular it affected the sale of American Bourbon and the US Government forced all Candian Distillers to put the country of origin on the label. So Club Whiskey simply became Canadian Club.

As prohibition took effect 75% of the illegal whisky in America came from Canada and Canadian Club became the #1 smuggled whisky to the USA.

TASTING NOTES

The nose is of medium-body with notes of barley sugar and aniseed, notes of cut grass and fennel, a hint of straw and a vegetal freshness. The palate is quite sweet and gentle spice and dark sugars.

NOSE:

Fresh and soft with an almond nuttiness, hint of peppery spice.

PALATE:

Spicy and zesty, complimented with hints of rick dark and sweet vanilla, pleasant sweetness.

FINISH:

Clean, dry and lingering with subtle oak.
